

Players are encouraged to spend as much time on the ball as possible

There are no throw-ins, free-kicks, kick-offs, or corners; if the ball goes out of play, parents and supporters are encouraged to throw it back on to the field

When a goal is scored, any parent can throw the ball back in to the middle of the field – the same applies for goal kicks

All players play in the game at the same time. If one team has more players, then they can either play with a substitute or give the opposition team a player. If one team has two more players, then they **must** give a player for the whole game. **Try to balance the teams as fairly as possible.**

Team coaches will be on the field to encourage players

The atmosphere is one of fun and involvement, rather than competition. **Bad language or poor behaviour will not be tolerated.**

The Club does not tolerate dirty play or poor sportsmanship – this includes parents and supporters. Any parent displaying poor behaviour deemed unacceptable by the ESAFC Board risks removal from the club, along with the child he/she is responsible for. This is at the sole discretion of the ESAFC Board.
